**STUDENT AND PARENT AGREEMENT**

- I agree to abide by high school and EFSC rules/policies. I am aware that I can lose dual enrollment eligibility and may be withdrawn from my EFSC classes if my behavior violates EFSC policies or disrupts instruction; I am also aware that instructors may fail a student as a consequence of academic dishonesty.
- I am aware that dual enrollment students will be in class and on campus with regular college students of varying ages and life experiences.
- I understand that EFSC courses, including lectures and materials, are developed for adult students and will not be modified to accommodate younger students.
- I understand that EFSCares, a student counseling service, is available to all EFSC students and that students may access the program without parent permission.
- I understand I am responsible for obtaining the required materials for my EFSC courses that my high school does NOT provide. Public school students must redeem bookstore vouchers no later than 2 weeks after the add/drop date for full terms and no later than 1 week after the add/drop date for shortened terms.
- I understand academic expectations are at the postsecondary level and that grades become a permanent part of my college and high school records. I authorize EFSC to forward my grades and report non-attendance and other concerns to my high school.
- I understand that I must maintain a college GPA of at least 2.0 to participate in dual enrollment in good standing; a GPA below 2.0 may result in loss of program eligibility for at least one term; students withdrawn from a class for non-attendance (NW) may lose program eligibility for at least one term.
- As a parent, I understand that, according to FERPA, I must have my child's written permission to access his/her EFSC record, that only my child can contact his/her EFSC instructor(s), and that I may attend a student/instructor conference only with my child's permission and with the understanding the conference is between the instructor and student.
- I certify that information on this form is true to the best of my knowledge. I am aware that any misrepresentation may result in application/registration cancellation.
